- **Initiated** or been **integral** to the setting up a conservation project.
- Shown **perseverance** in seeking to ensure that the project keeps going.
- **Inspired** others to have become involved and actively contribute to the project(s).
- Achieved or be moving toward achieving recognised conservation gains.

They will be:

- A current member of KCC or Forest & Bird.
- Under 18 years (or still at school)

The Award winner will be invited to receive their award at the Society's AGM / Conference Sanderson Memorial Dinner – 23 June 2018 in Wellington. Flights and accommodation for the winner and one guardian will be covered by Forest & Bird.
