



What's YOUR VISION for the future?

Design a T-shirt to tell the world!

Criteria:

The theme is "my vision for the future". You can focus your design on:

- a particular native animal or plant, or a place that is important to you
- a type of environment (e.g. forest or ocean)
- an activity you'd like to see people doing more, or less (e.g. using less plastic).

Your T-shirt can have a picture on it, or a slogan, or a combination of both. **The design can go anywhere on the front of a t-shirt, but needs to fit into a 20cm x 20cm shape.**

What we'll do:

We'll pick three age group winners, and an overall winner. Our age groups are:

- Under 7
- 8-10 years
- 11 years and up

The winner from each group will win a KCC membership for their school or community group.

The overall winner will have their T-shirt made – with the possibility it will also be produced for the Forest & Bird Shop, and sold to fundraise money for nature. WOW!

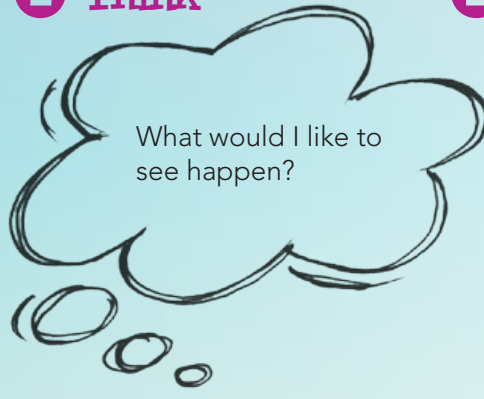
Think about your favourite T-shirt. Chances are, it has a picture or words on it. Am I right?

Instructions:

1 Think



2 Measure & Cut-out

No bigger than 20cm x 20cm



3 Lay it out

Get a t-shirt and lay your shape out on it

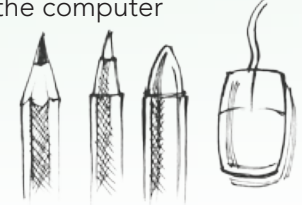


4 Sketch



5 Make a final copy

Use paint, felts, crayons, or the computer
