
WHAT'S THE MOST COLOURFUL NZ NATIVE BIRD?

An orange-fronted kākāriki has six distinct bright colours - green, yellow, orange, red, white, and blue. However, if we consider iridescence - that is, the coloured shimmer that occurs when the light hits some feathers just right - there are many other birds who could be up for the title, including kea, tūī, takahē, and kererū.
