

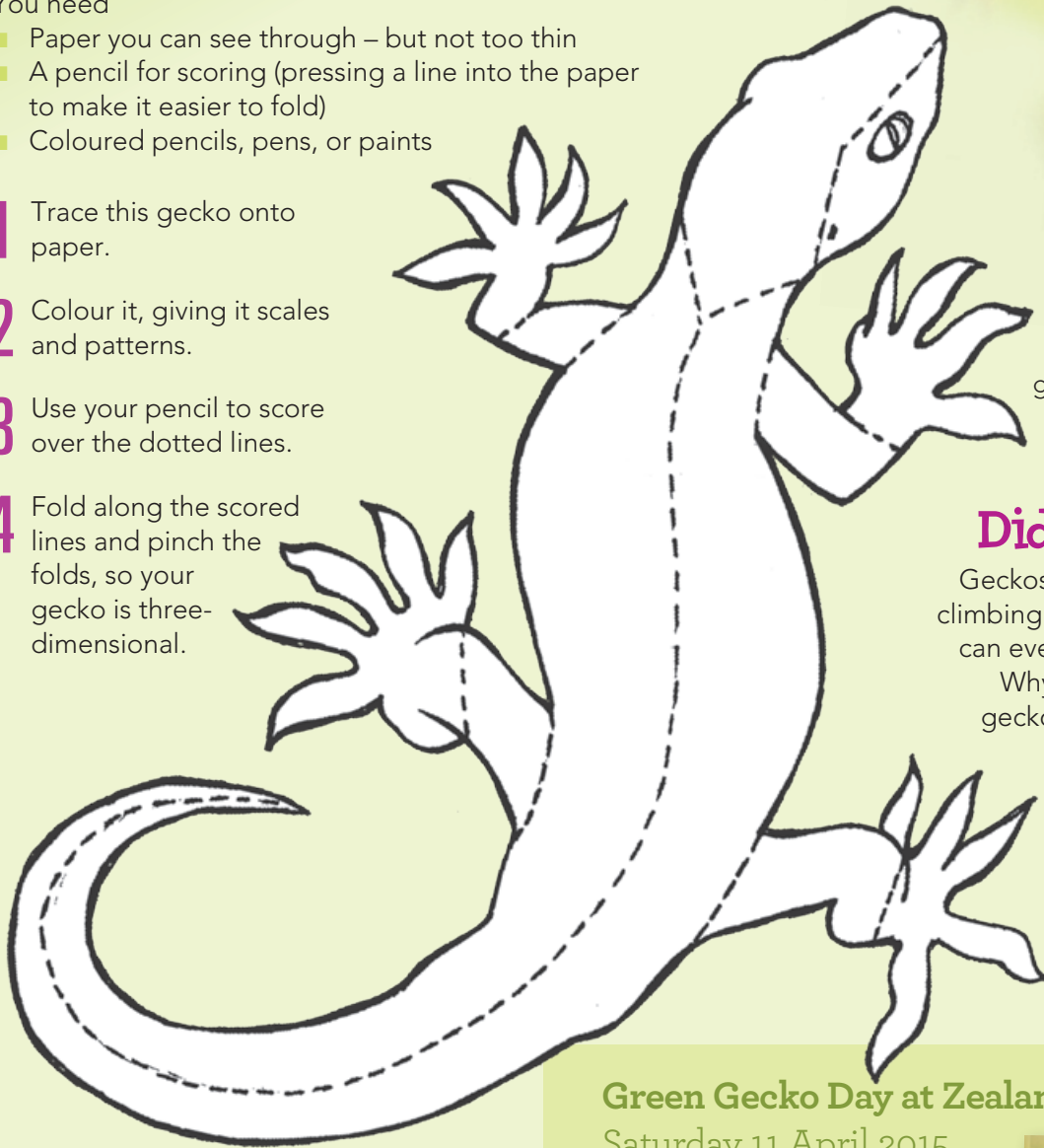
Make a green gecko

with Margaret Tolland

You need

- Paper you can see through – but not too thin
- A pencil for scoring (pressing a line into the paper to make it easier to fold)
- Coloured pencils, pens, or paints

- 1 Trace this gecko onto paper.
- 2 Colour it, giving it scales and patterns.
- 3 Use your pencil to score over the dotted lines.
- 4 Fold along the scored lines and pinch the folds, so your gecko is three-dimensional.
