

Recycle a tin

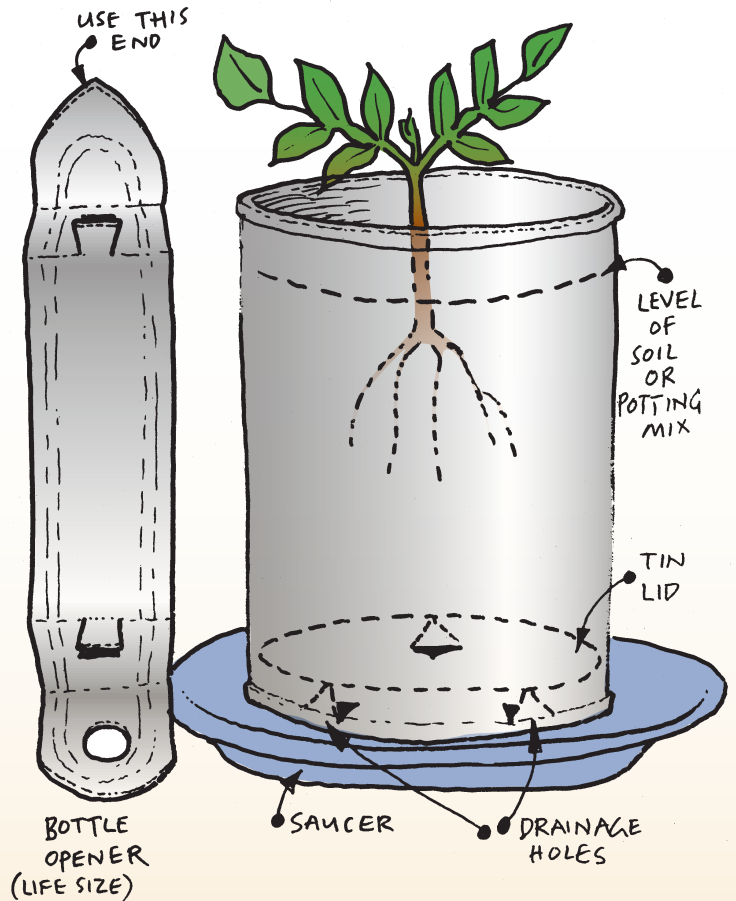
Make a plant pot

You will need:

- An empty tin and its lid
- Bottle opener
- Potting mix
- Seeds (Sunflower, beans or peas are good).
- An old saucer or lid

What to do:

- With a bottle opener (the sort shown in the picture), make 3 v-shaped holes in the bottom of the tin. The 'V' should be pointing upward.
- Drop the lid into the bottom of the tin so it rests on the points. Almost fill the tin with soil or potting mix.

- The lid will allow water to drain out while keeping the soil from falling out of the holes.
- You can decorate the tin with a coloured paper wrapper.
- Plant the seeds in the tin and water. The seeds can be transplanted into the garden when they are the same height as the tin.
