Don't pull them out!

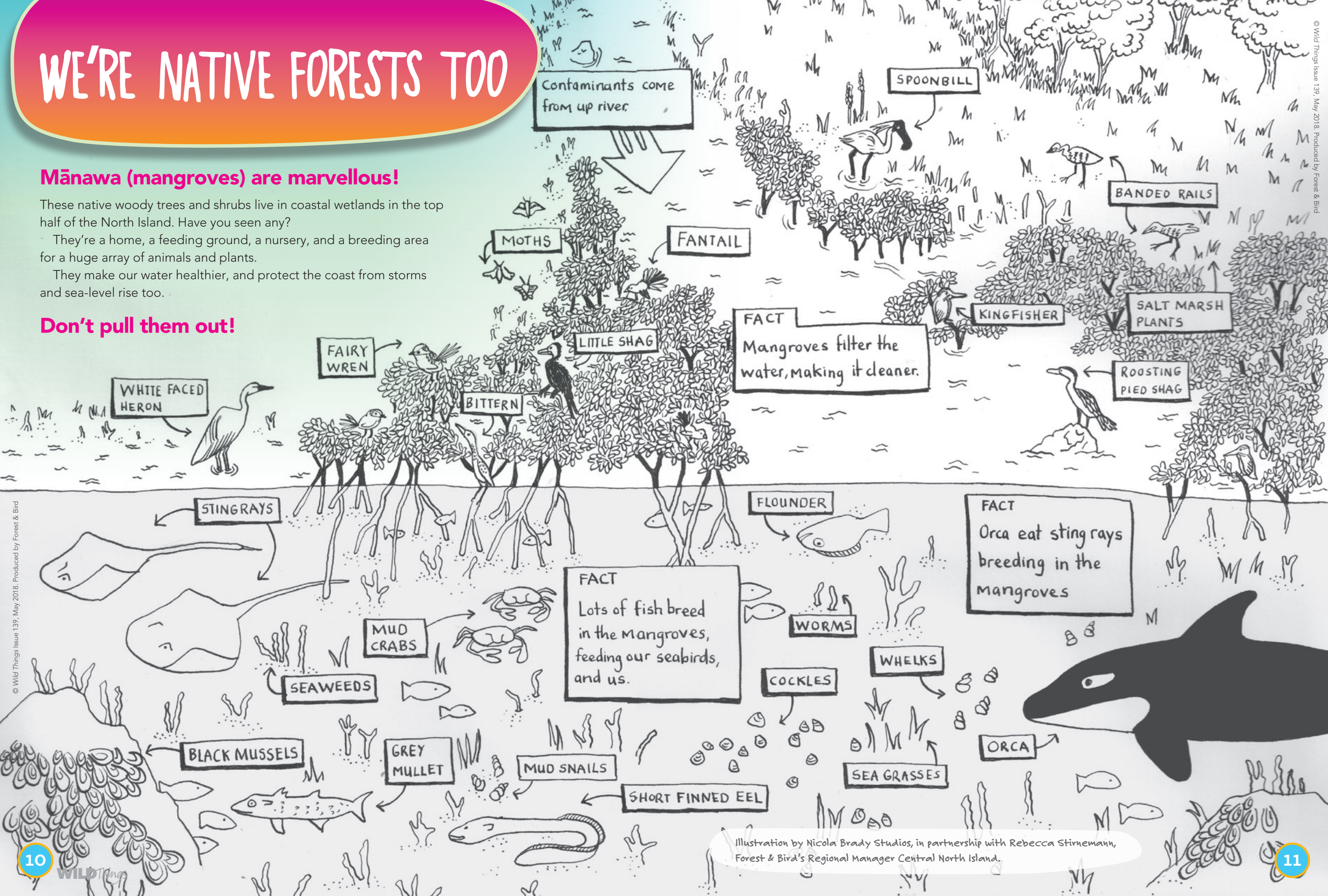
