



FORGOTTEN SOCKS



We all have an odd sock now and then. Do something good with yours. Up-cycle it into a socktopus!

Instructions



1 Screw up used paper into a ball. Keep wrapping more around until it's the size of a tennis ball. Stuff into sock.



3 Form a swirl at the base of the ball.



5 Pull end of sock back down. Cut it to make eight legs.



2 Twist up the sock tight.



4 Holding swirl in place, pull the end of the sock up over it. Tie off swirl tight with thread or wool. This makes a base so your socktopus can sit up.



6 Cut out three circles of felt material. Stick them together with glue to make an eye. Repeat. Stick onto your socktopus.
