

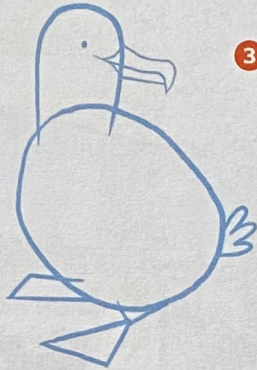
Draw an albatross chick

1 Pencil in these rough shapes.



2 Add a tail, beak, and eye. The beak can be a bit tricky. If it doesn't look right first time, keep trying!



3 Using your pencil lines as a guide, take a pen and make your albatross fluffy. Add detail to its beak and feet.



4 Rub out your pencil lines – you're done!



You can give your albatross chick a different expression by changing its eye. Can you make it grumpy, sleepy, or surprised?
