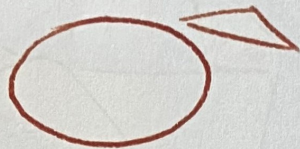


Draw an Archey's frog

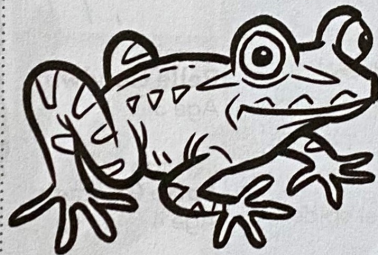
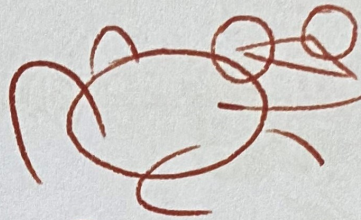
(*Leiopelma archeyi*) with Gavin Mouldey

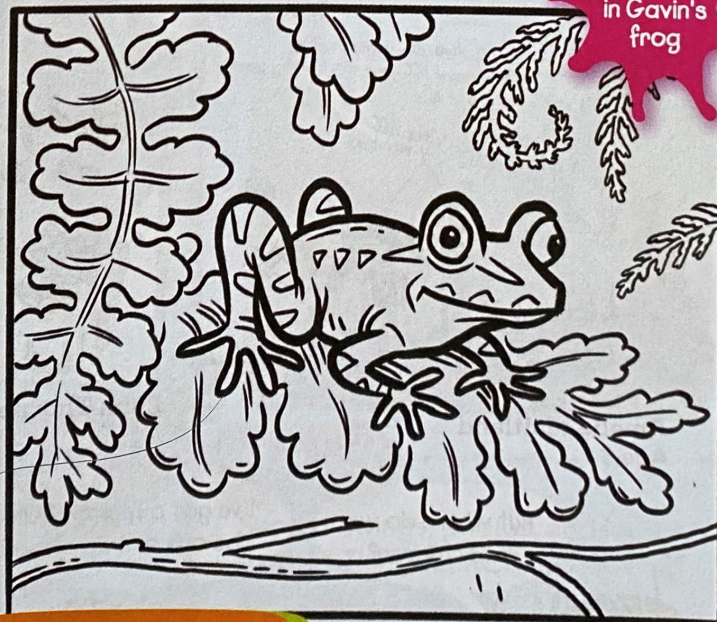
With a pencil, lightly draw the main shapes.
