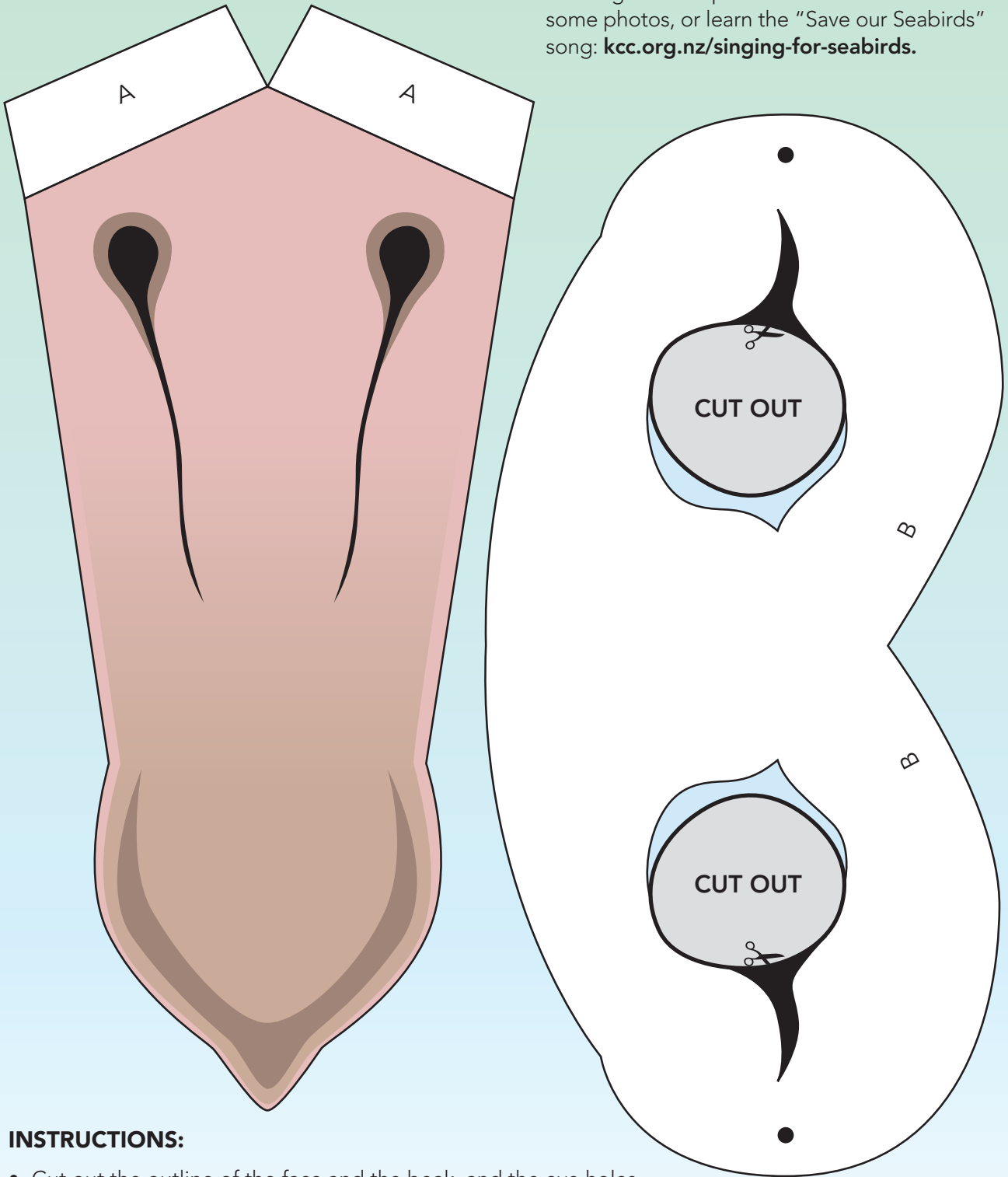


# What to do:

Represent the toroa on World Albatross Day by making and wearing this mask when you're at school, at home, or out and about.

You might like to pose with outstretched arms for some photos, or learn the "Save our Seabirds" song: [kcc.org.nz/singing-for-seabirds](http://kcc.org.nz/singing-for-seabirds).



## INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut out the outline of the face and the beak, and the eye holes.
- Make a small hole where the two dots are. Attach elastic to fit round your head.
- Fold the two flaps marked A down behind the beak, then stick flaps A to where it is marked B, following the edge of the mask.
